AQUATICS LEADERSHIP PROGRAM

ARE YOU A STRONG SWIMMER, UP TO THE CHALLENGE OF EARNING YOUR QUALIFICATIONS TO BE A LIFEGUARD?

Earn two high school credits (IDP30 and PAQ30) in one semester, as well as the aquatic courses needed to be a trained lifeguard, certified to work anywhere in Canada.

No prior certification is needed, but you must be a competent swimmer.

Upon successful completion, students will receive the following:

- 2 high school credits (IDP30 & PA30)
- leadership skills
- Emergency First Aid
- Standard First Aid
- Automated External Defibrillator
- Bronze Medallion Certification (Lifesaving Society)
- Bronze Cross Certification (Lifesaving Society)
- National Lifesaving Certification (Lifesaving Society)

Cost: Approximately **\$425**. This fee can be paid in installments throughout the course. If a student is having financial difficulties, we can facilitate an application to the Jump Start program. Please speak to the teacher, or the Principal if you are concerned about the course fee.
