Cooperative Education Grade 12,

COP4X2 (2 Credit), COP4X4 (4 Credit)

Cooperative Education offers a unique opportunity for students to gain hands on experience in a working environment, while satisfying high school diploma requirements. A co-op placement in the community can open doors to further employment as well as give important insight into future career choices. It also provides valuable experiences that could enhance a student's acceptance into college and university programs. A Cooperative Education course can be linked to any other high school course and is identified by the linked course code on the student's transcript.

Course Note: To apply for a co-op experience, just identify your interest in co-op (one, two or four credit package) on your course selection sheet and you will be contacted by the Co-op Department.

Geoventure

Grade 12 University/College

SNC/PAF (4 credit)

Geoventure is a 4 credit course that provides students with a cooperative education placement in the community, leadership skills and opportunities, outdoor tripping, field work, and land stewardship experiences, as well as specific training in WHMIS, First Aid and CPR. Students will obtain credits in the following areas: Grade 112 University/College Food and Nutrition, Grade 12 University/College Fitness Leadership and 2 Co-op credits in an area of interest, decided upon by the student under the guidance of the Co-op Department. A certification and field trip fee is required.
