CAN YOUR CHILD GRADUATE???

STUDENTS NEED:

- 30 credits (18 compulsory, 12 elective)
- 20 hours of community service
- to pass Literacy test or course



UNIVERSITY INFORMATION

- students need six Grade 12 University or University/College credits to apply
- includes pre-requisites for program
- ENG4U is required for ALL programs
- students apply at www.ouac.on.ca

UNIVERSITY RESEARCH

- information about university programs in Ontario - www.ontariouniversitiesinfo.ca
- for schools outside of Ontario, you must go directly to the school's website for both information about courses and to apply

UNIVERSITY APPLICATIONS

- university applications open on **October 1**
- the deadline for applications is **January 15, 2021**

APPLICATION FEE

- \$156 for 3 program choices
- \$50 for each additional choice

- marks are sent to the OUAC by Ms. Coccimiglio

OTHER IMPORTANT DATES

- students can receive offers between **January 15 and May 27, 2021**
- the deadline to accept an offer is **June 1, 2021**



UNIVERSITY TERMINOLOGY

Bachelor Degree

- three or four (Honours) years

Masters Degree

- completed AFTER an Honours degree

Doctorate (Ph.D)

- completed AFTER a Masters degree

UNIVERSITY

Tuition - \$6,000 - \$12,000

Residence - \$6,000 - \$7,000 (may not include meal plan)

Books - \$1000 (average)

Plus food, phone, laundry, entertainment etc....

COLLEGE INFORMATION

- students need a high school diploma with a Grade 12 English and any pre-requisites for their program
- students apply AND research programs at www.ontariocolleges.ca

COLLEGE APPLICATIONS

- college applications open on **October 9**,
- the deadline for applications is **February 1, 2021**
- \$95 for five program choices only
- three can be at the same school
- marks are sent to OCAS by Ms. Coccimiglio

OTHER IMPORTANT DATES

- students can receive offers between **February 1 and April 30, 2021**
- the deadline to accept an offer is **May 1, 2021**
- tuition deposits are due on **June 21, 2021**



COLLEGE TERMINOLOGY

Certificate -

- 1 year or less of study; skill specific

Diploma

- 2 years of study

Advanced Diploma

- 3 years of study

COLLEGE

Tuition - \$2,000 - \$6,000

Residence - \$6,000 - \$7,000 (may not include meal plan)

Books - \$1000 (average)

Plus food, phone, laundry, entertainment etc....

APPRENTICESHIP TERMINOLOGY

Journey person

- a person who has completed an apprenticeship

Apprentice -

- a trainee learning a skilled trade working directly with a journey person

Red Seal -

- allows an apprentice to work in any province

OYAP

- Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program

HOW MUCH IS THIS GOING TO COST?!?!

APPRENTICESHIP

- Tuition -** \$0 - you get paid to learn
- Tools -** will vary depending on trade
- day to day living costs depending on one's situation

STUDENTS WITH AN IEP

- this website will help guide students with an IEP through the process of transitioning to university or college
- it outlines what services you are entitled to once you go away to school
- it also outlines financial aid opportunities
